WHEN is the Municipal Election?

Monday, October 25th, 2010

SCHEDULE OF KEY DATES	
January 4, 2010	Nominations may be filed during regular office hours
September 7, 2010 – October 25, 2010	Revision Period for Voter's List
September 10, 2010	Nomination Day – Nominations accepted from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
September 10, 2010	Final date to Withdraw Nominations by 2:00 p.m.
September 13, 2010	Nominations to be certified or rejected by the Clerk List of Candidates to be posted by 4:00 p.m.
October 25, 2010	Election Day (10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.)

Elected Official Offices to be elected:

Reeve – One (1) to be elected at large

Deputy-Reeve – One (1) to be elected at large

Councillors – Five (5) to be elected for each of the 5 wards

Term of Office for Elected Officials:

December 1st, 2010 to November 30, 2014 (four year term)

Ward Boundaries:

- WARD 1:** Haliburton – Lots 12 to 20 inclusive, Concessions 7 to 9 inclusive, in the Township of Dysart
- WARD 2:** Haliburton – All of the Township of Dysart except Ward 1 and all of the Township of Dudley, except Lot 35, Concessions 6 & 7, in the Township of Dudley
- WARD 3:** Harcourt – All of the Townships of Harcourt, Bruton and Clyde and Lot 35, Concessions 6 & 7, in the Township of Dudley
- WARD 4:** West Guilford – Lots 1 to 18 inclusive, Concessions 1 to 6 inclusive, Township of Guilford and Lots 1 to 25 inclusive, Concessions 7 to 13 inclusive, Township of Guilford and all of the Township of Havelock.
- WARD 5:** Eagle Lake – All of the Township of Guilford except Ward 4 and all of the Townships of Harburn and Eyre.

WHO is Eligible to Vote?

You are qualified to vote in the Municipality of Dysart et al Election if you are:

- ✓ A Canadian Citizen
- ✓ At least 18 years of age
- ✓ A resident of the Municipality of Dysart et al, or a non-resident owner or tenant of land in the Municipality of Dysart et al or their spouse
- ✓ Not prohibited from voting under any law

You can only vote **once** regardless of how many Municipality of Dysart et al properties you own or rent.

The following do not qualify to vote in a municipal election:

- Anyone serving a sentence in a prison,
- Anyone acting as a representative for someone else, except as a certified Proxy Voter,
- Anyone convicted of a corrupt election practice within the past five years, or
- A corporation.
