Re: Harburn Holdings, Grass Lake - Official Plan and Zoning Bylaw Amendments

I am following up on our recent discussions about the public involvement strategy submitted as part of my Planning Report.

As you know, the strategy included the following (as well as other) additional consultation methods:

- ▶ I will prepare a summary print/digital package describing the proposal.
- ▶ No later than the date of submission of the applications, I will circulate the summary package, by email to the LKO, and by mail to the above stakeholders [a larger group than those entitled to statutory notice from the Municipality]. (The Municipality has kindly agreed to undertake the mailing, as the assessment roll is currently not accessible to us due to the COVID-19 emergency.)
- ▶ If the review process results in significant changes to the proposal, I will revise and recirculate the summary package.

Accordingly, I prepared an initial summary package dated June 1, 2021, and a supplementary package dated April 20, 2022.

Unfortunately, it has proven impossible to fully implement the mailing aspect of this commitment, particularly with regard to the second mailing, due to the limitations of the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* as well as COVID-19. Therefore, we are withdrawing from the mailing commitment and trust this will be acceptable to you.

Of course, these two packages have still been posted on the Municipality's Current Development Applications webpage, and I am confident you will do the same with any future packages.
