Notice of a Complete Application and Public Meeting Concerning a Proposed Zoning By-Law Amendment

Take Notice that the Municipality of Dysart et al has received a complete application to amend the Municipality's Zoning By-law. The site-specific amendment applies to land located on Part Lot 16, Concession 10, Block G, Plan 404 in the Geographic Township of Guilford, now in the Municipality of Dysart et al. (See key map).

Purpose and Effect: The proposed amending By-law would change the zoning as follows:

- Severed Lot - From Rural Type 1L (RU1L) zone to Rural Residential-XX (RR-XX) exception zone for intended use and front yard setback as applied by section 14.4.5 of the Municipal Official Plan.
- Retained Lot - From Rural Type 1L (RU1L) zone to Rural Type 1L-XX (RU1L-XX) exception zone to recognize the reduced lot area of the property and Environmental Protection (EP) zone to implement appropriate development setback from the identified water feature on the subject property.

And Take Notice that the Municipality of Dysart et al will be holding a Public Meeting as required under the Planning Act. The Public Meeting is an opportunity for Council to hear and consider comments related to the proposed amendments. Any member of the public may speak in favour, or opposition to, the proposed amendments during the Public Meeting.

Any person may attend the public meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council for the Municipality of Dysart et al to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Municipality of Dysart et al before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision. The person or public body may not be

added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Municipality of Dysart et al in respect to the proposed zoning by-law amendment, you must submit a written request to the Municipality of Dysart et al.
