BY-LAW NO. 2015-53

BEING A BY-LAW TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF OFF-ROAD VEHICLES (ORV)  
ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF  
THE MUNICIPALITY OF DYSART ET AL

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to section 191.8 (1) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, chapter H.8, as amended, no person shall drive an off-road vehicle on a highway except in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act regulations and any applicable municipal by-laws;

**AND WHEREAS**, section 191.8, subsection (3) (a) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, chapter H.8, as amended, provides that the Municipality may pass by-laws permitting the operation of certain off-road vehicles on any highway within the Municipality that is under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Dysart et al, or on any part or parts of such highways;


**AND WHEREAS**, Section 1 of the Ontario Regulation 316/03 defines off-road vehicles;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Dysart et al deems it in the best public interest to permit the operation of off-road vehicles on certain highways under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Dysart et al;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Corporation of the United Townships of Dysart et al enacts as follows:

1. Pursuant to this By-law the definition of "off-road vehicles" shall be as defined in the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
2. That multi-purpose off-highway utility vehicles, recreational off-highway vehicles and all-terrain vehicles shall be permitted on all Highways under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Dysart et al in accordance with the provisions of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, save and except Highland Street between Cedar Avenue and Dysart Avenue.
3. That any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction, is liable to a fine as provided for under the Highway Traffic Act.
4. That By-law No. 2009-102 be and is hereby repealed.
5. That the provisions of this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2015.
