

EXPANSION OF THE
HALIBURTON SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT

PURPOSE OF THE STUDY:

In May 1986, the Ontario Provincial Government approved a grant to extend the Haliburton sanitary sewer system to the north shore of Lake Kashagawigamog up to the Willow Beach Cottages. The extension is expected to have a substantial long term economic impact on the Haliburton area. It will create an opportunity for tourism and commercial establishments to grow, which in turn will create new employment opportunities in the community.

The existing sewage treatment plant does not have adequate capacity to accommodate additional flows from the sanitary sewer extension or from future population growth within the Hamlet of Haliburton.

To meet the effluent quality criteria, and accommodate additional flows to the plant, the existing sewage treatment plant requires the expansion of the plant capacity.

However, before detailed design of the plant expansion is completed, a study is being undertaken to evaluate all the factors relating to the required expansion, including the following:

- * existing plant performance
- * projected future population and sewage flows
- * effluent quality criteria
- * environmental concerns and constraints
- * project costs and construction timing

The panels which are displayed at this Information Centre outline our approach to the study, in accordance with the Ministry of the Environment's Class Environmental Assessment Planning and Design Process for Municipal Sewage Projects.

The purpose of this Information Centre is to inform the public about the study and to solicit public input prior to selecting the preferred solution.

THE STUDY PROCESS

The following chart outlines the Study Process to establish design criteria and recommendation for the expansion.

- TASK 1** Review previous studies and reports and evaluate population projections.
- TASK 2** Review sewage flow data and predict future plant flows
- TASK 3** Identify alternative solutions
- TASK 4** Select treatment type and location
- TASK 5** Evaluate environmental concerns and constraints
- TASK 6** Develop preferred solution and identify components of proposed expansion as well as cost
- TASK 7** Prepare Class Environmental Assessment Phase 1 and 2 Report
- TASK 8** Review findings with interested agencies and public
- TASK 9** Prepare draft Environmental Study Report (ESR)
- TASK 10** Final 30 day review of ESR by Government Agencies and public
- TASK 11** Submit Final ESR/Predesign Report and Application for M.O.E. Approval
