Remedial Action Information Sheet: Site Plan, Parking Spaces

The Short-Term Rental By-Law requires a Site Plan for the property that is accurate and reflects the location of all structures, wells, parking and the septic location on the property. During the most recent Short-Term Rental inspection, the inspector found that the property does not match the Site Plan provided on your application

1. Site Plan

- a. A new, accurate redrawn Site Plan labelling each structure, parking spaces, wells and the location of the septic as well as measurements from the high water mark to be submitted to str@dysartetel.ca

Timeline: These infractions provide you with a timeline of 10 Days from the date of the report to submit the documentation. Please submit your follow up to str@dysartetel.ca.

Non-Compliance: Failure to address a failed portion of the inspection can lead to enforcement actions by the Municipality including orders, fees, demerits points and the Short-Term Rental Licence being revoked.
