Let's Talk... **Melting Snow and Flood Control**

If the temperature rises above zero degrees Celsius in a short period of time there is a possibility of flooding as a result of rapidly melting snow and ice. The outcome of maintaining drainage systems is to ensure they function as intended, reducing potential flooding conditions that could present a safety hazard or that could degrade the quality of the infrastructure.

Municipal crews remove snow and ice from catch basins on roads and sidewalks to ensure melting snow will be able to drain when required.

Roadside culverts and ditches are cleared at the outlet end of the ditch system to provide drainage for the spring melt. Municipal crews prioritize known critical areas in an attempt to minimize the risk of flooding as clearing operations are not designed to drain all ditches of water.

Residents are encouraged to help by clearing snow and ice from catch basins near their homes.
