The Glebe Park and Museum Committee is a permanent committee of Council with a mandate to:

The Committee meets Bi-monthly in the Dysart et al Council Chambers at 2:00 p.m. on the second Tuesday of the month. (February, April, June, August, October, December)

The Glebe Park and Museum Committee is comprised of two elected members of Council and one representative from the following key stakeholder groups: Fleming College, Haliburton Sculpture Forest, Haliburton Highlands Nordic Trail Association, Haliburton County Snowmobile Association, Haliburton-By-The-Lake Neighbourhood Association, Haliburton Highlands Mountain Bike Club and the Haliburton Highlands Museum.

Current representation from these groups includes Deputy-Reeve Andrea Roberts, Councillor Tammy Donaldson, Chairperson Jim Blake, Joan Willhelm, Mike Darlington, Ted Brandon, Thom Lambert, Tom Nicholson and Tim Hagarty. The Municipal Clerk, the Director of the Museum and the Director of Parks and Recreation provide support to this Committee.
