BURNING PERMIT RULES

All persons setting an open air fire in the Municipality of Dysart et al (during the day) shall first obtain a fire permit form the Fire Department pursuant to this section. The material to be burned shall be limited to wood or by-products of wood. A person who has obtained a fire permit pursuant to this section shall abide by the rules of Municipality of Dysart et al By-law #2015-52, including:

- a) not permit more than two (2) cubic metres of material to be burned at any one time;
- b) ensure that the fire is at least 3 metres away from property lines, buildings, fences, trees and roadways;
- c) ensure that the means of extinguishing the fire designated in the permit form is available at the site at all times during the fire;
- d) ensure the fire is attended at all times;
- e) not burn on weekends;
- f) will be subject to a fine for contravention of By-law # 2015-52;
- g) will be subject to fire department response expenses incurred, for response to any fire resulting from a set open air fire;
