3. Outdoor space is approximately 10' x 10'.
4. Event management will not be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to exhibits.
5. No stakes in ground without approval (sprinkler system in park area).
6. Exhibit or tables are for showcasing, display and vending purposes only. Draws, raffles are encouraged at your table.
7. If food is being served you must obtain any required permits from HKPR Health Unit.
8. It is the Vendor's responsibility to have their own coverage/insurance for public liability, bodily injury, property damage and product liability.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for the removal of all wares, recycling and garbage at space. LEAVE YOUR SPACE CLEAN.
10. No use of burning/open flames.
11. No refunds on space rental.
12. Event management holds the right to reject or restrict exhibits.
13. No use of public address system.
14. Do not set up an independent wiring system.
15. No blockage of aisles or neighboring displays.
16. There are no passes, therefore company name badges are strongly recommended.
